Sand River Part 6 of 9

Between portages 17 and 18 lining the canoe over a 90 m stretch may be necessary during periods of low water.

Portage 18 avoids a section of fast flowing water and boulder rapids. Use the 130 m portage on the left around the first set of boulder rapids. The next 170 m of rapids can be portaged or run in high water or lined in low water.

Between portage 19 and 20 a branch of the old Sand River road crosses the river.
