### INVITATION TO COMMENT INITIAL PUBLIC NOTICE PROPOSED PRESQU'ILE ISLANDS IMPLEMENTATION PLAN

The **Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR), Ontario Parks** is inviting comments on its proposal to develop and implement an ecosystem-based implementation plan for the Presqu'île Provincial Park Islands. The plan will include detailed direction for double-crested cormorant management, deer management, and vegetation restoration on High Bluff and Gull Islands.

The animal population management and vegetation restoration projects of the proposal will be evaluated under the Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Parks and Conservation Reserves. Cormorant management will be evaluated as a Category C project. The implementation plan will meet the Environmental Study Report (ESR) requirements for this Category C project. Deer management and vegetation restoration will be evaluated as Category B projects.

Written comments must be received within the 30-day comment period, which will expire on **December 29, 2008**. To provide comments, to be placed on the project mailing list, or for more information on the project please contact:

This information may be used by the Ministry of Natural Resources to seek public input on other resource management surveys and projects.
